

Corrections to the Vienna Code

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Since the publication of the Vienna Code (McNeill & al., 2006) on 20 September 2006, several errors have come to our attention. Most are minor punctuation or cross-referencing errors, or, in the Appendices, inconsistencies in abbreviation, but there was one important omission from Art. 37, a misspelling of a name in Appendix III, the misspelling of two specific epithets and the transposition of a pair of type citations in App. IV, and an erroneous type citation in App. V.

The errors that have been noted to date are listed below. In addition, some minor inconsistencies and typographical errors have been discovered and new information on the authorship of certain names has come to light. The modifications and additions reflecting these are not listed here, but will be incorporated as appropriate in translations and other future publications. The inconsistencies discovered principally involve Appendices IV & V and include the removal of redundancy in type citations, e.g., the initials of collectors, and the provision of some additional cross-references.

page ix paragraph 3 (para. [8] of Preface) last line: replace “Ex. 18” by “Ex. 33”

Rec. 50A line 1 (page 90): replace the first clause (the words up to the comma) by “In the citation of a name that is not validly published because it was merely cited as a synonym,”
